*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
And by the authority of the same, as follow*

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 175C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in section c the following sentence:-
- 3 Notwithstanding clause (2), the commissioner shall consider the effects of predicted
- 4 hurricane losses and the cost of catastrophe reinsurance on the rates charged by voluntary
- 5 market insurers and the cost of catastrophe reinsurance and the predicted hurricane losses
- 6 on the association approving rates for homeowners insurance in all territories.
